

JAKE MARTIN



Jake Martin is a theatre artist, comedian and writer originally from rural New Brunswick. He has performed coast-to-coast in Canada and New York with numerous companies including Second City Toronto, Theatre New Brunswick, Saint John Theatre Company and the premiere tour of Len Falkenstein's **Lac/Athabasca** ("Outstanding Ensemble - Summerworks 2015" NOW Magazine).

He graduated from St. Thomas University and served as the president of **Theatre St. Thomas**, and then worked under Ryan Griffith at the **Next Folding Theatre Company**, where he facilitated and oversaw the creation of numerous new scripts from New Brunswick writers. He served as the Artistic Director of the company for the 2014-2015 season where he directed the premiere production of Journey Award Shortlist winner Emily Bossé's **Cocaine Plane**. He was also a founding member of New Brunswick comedy groups, **Hot Garbage Comedy** and **Dead Serious Comedy**, and has toured his work across Canada.

After moving to Toronto in 2015, Jake graduated from the **Second City Conservatory** program and joined the Canadian Comedy award-winning sketch comedy group, **The Sketchersons**. His short dark comedy **Someone Gets Shot** was selected by Samuel French for their 2018 OOB Short Play Festival and was shortlisted for the Carol Tambor Award at the Edinburgh Fringe Festival. Recently he has been touring his solo sketch comedy show, **Snakes Are Cool**, which received the "Best Sketch Show" award at the 2024 Halifax Fringe Festival.

Hot Garbage Comedy – (Improv) A improv comedy group founded by Jake Martin, Jean-Michel Cliche, Alexa Higgins and Brett Loughery. The company produced monthly comedy shows around New Brunswick as well as some improv and sketch revues in Toronto, ON.
